THREE PATHS TO PENNSYLVANIA'S TESTING REQUIREMENTS

KEYSTONE PROFICIENCY PATHWAY

Student earns a score of proficient or advanced on all Keystone Exams: Algebra, Biology and Literature

KEYSTONE COMPOSITE PATHWAY

Students Keystone Exam results meet the following criteria:

- At least 1 Keystone Exam score of Proficient or Advanced
- No Keystone Exam score of Below Basic
- Composite exam scores of 4452 or greater
 - The combination of Algebra, Literature and Biology scores

ALTERNATIVE PATHWAYS

Students must pass (60%) their Algebra, Biology and English II courses and meet one of the following alternative paths.

Career and Technical Path

Industry Based Certification
or
Successful completion of
CPACTC program and exams

Alternative Assessment Path

ASVAB score: 31 *or*
PSAT score: 970 *or*
SAT score 1010 *or*
Enrolled in Ship Start or other 4 year
college for dual enrollment

Evidence Based Path - 3 pieces of evidence *1 or more of the following:*

- An AP exam score of 3 or higher
- Passing a college course while in high school
- Industry-based credential
- Enrolled in HACC or other 2yr school for dual enrollment

No more than 2 of the following:

- Proficient or advanced on a Keystone
- Letter of enlistment with the military
- Compliance with NCAA Division II academic requirements
