BUILDINGS AND PROPERTY COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

TUESDAY, DECEMBER 2, 2014

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I. CALL TO ORDER

The Buildings and Property Committee of the Board of School Directors for the Big Spring School District met in the Large Group Room, Room 140, of the Big Spring High School at 6:40 P.M. with Robert L. Barrick, Committee Chairperson presiding. Six (6) directors present: Robert Barrick, Committee Chairperson; William Swanson, Committee Member; Wilbur Wolf, Jr, ex-officio Committee Member; Kingsley Blasco, Board Member; Richard Norris, Board Member; and William Piper Board Member.

II. DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. Oak Flat Paving

Mr. Rick Gilliam, Director of Buildings, Grounds, and Transportation and Mr. Chris Beauregard, CenterPoint will discuss with the Board of School Directors phase II of the paving project.

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General Questions:

1. Mr. Wolf inquired about the gate on the right fitting to the curb but what about the gate on the left.
2. Mr. Barrick asked how the speed hump would affect snow plowing.
3. Mr. Barrick questioned the milling around the speed hump and how deep it would be.
4. Mr. Wolf inquired the cost of the speed humps
5. Mr. Kerr informed the Board of School Directors the two smaller projects would be done as local projects under supervision of the facilities office. The administration feels these projects can be done through local bidders.
6. Mr. Barrick inquired if the paving contractors will be supplying the signs or will it be handled outside the project.
7. Mr. Piper asked about the \$85,000 paving fabric. Is there a local bidder or a Pennsylvania company that can supply this?

B. Other

Mr. Rick Gilliam, Director of Buildings, Grounds, and Transportation will discuss with the Board of School Directors the High School Pool Pak.

General Questions:

1. Mr. Barrick inquired if the lumber under the pool pak is what was put in when the school was built.
2. Mr. Fry informed the Board of School Directors we will have to get a crane. This is what we held off doing as we repaired the roof. This is just information on what we want to do in the future with the pool pak. The area under the HS pool pak needs to be addressed.
3. Mr. Barrick inquired if we paid them for their services on the roof.
