Math	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 1 ½" to 2" three ring binder ● Calculator: TI 30-XS Multiview (Optional) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ We have a classroom set, so you do not need to purchase. ○ If you have a calculator that you bought in 6th grade, please bring it with you. 
Social Studies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 1" three ring binder OR folder
Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 1 pocket folder ● 2 Composition notebooks (100 sheets NOT spiral bound)
English Language Arts (ELA)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● 1" binder ● Composition notebook for Leuschen/Rickabaugh
All Classes (students might have these already)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Ear buds/Headphones ● Regular pencils (plenty of wooden and/or mechanical with refillable lead) ● Pens ● Lined paper for all binders (50 pages in each)
