- Mr. Kanc questioned, technology wise if he has everything that he needs to go out into the work force and compete against others for a job.

- 5. Mr. Blasco inquired how many shop foreman does the vo-tech have. Did I understand that you are the foreman for 19 students?
- 6. Mr. Wolf asked if he still has time to do the technical part of welding.
- 7. Dr. Fry informed the Board of School Directors that 17 percent of our high school students go to the vo-tech. We are one of a few school districts that have two members represented on the board. We continue to grow. We are one of three districts that send freshman to the vo-tech. Kudos to Cumberland Perry for all they do for our students. They have 13 sending district.
