If your child turns four on or before **September 1, 2020** now is the time to call about enrolling your child into Head Start or Pre-K Counts! If you are a pregnant mom or have a child from birth to age 3, we are also enrolling today for Early Head Start

Pre-K Counts, Head Start & Early Head Start offers quality preschool/classroom/home experiences at **no cost to you** to help your child learn the skills they need to be ready and excited for kindergarten.

**Head Start:** Serving the following school districts, Carlisle, South Middleton, Shippensburg & Big Spring (Newville) & surrounding areas. Classrooms are 5 days a week and run for 5 ½ hours a day.

**Early Head Start:** Serving the following school districts, Carlisle, South Middleton, Shippensburg & Big Spring (Newville) & surrounding areas. Pregnant moms & children birth thru age 3 (90 min. Educational home visit once a week & Socialization twice a month).

### Who Should Apply?

- Children who turn 4 on or before **September 1, 2020** for Head Start.
- Pregnant moms & children from birth to age 3 for Early Head Start/homebased.
- Children who live in families who are at or below the 100% federal poverty level.
- Transportation is provided to some locations.

**PRE-K:** Serving the following school districts, Carlisle, South Middleton, Shippensburg & Newville School Districts & surrounding areas. Classrooms are 5 days a week and are 5 ½ hours long.

### Who Should Apply?

- Children who turn 4 on or before **September 1, 2020**
- Children who live in families who are at or below the 300% federal poverty level.

**Selection will begin in May, so now is the time to get your application in.**
